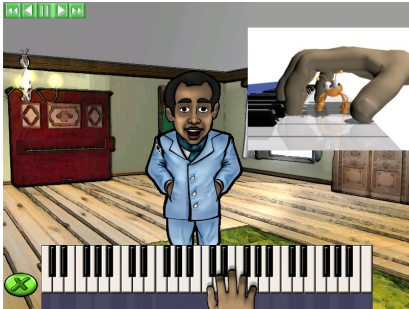




## Lesson 13

### This Week at Home

- You and Miss Melody will make up a new song together. You can give this new song a fun name like Mr. Scott Joplin does. What is the name of your new song?
