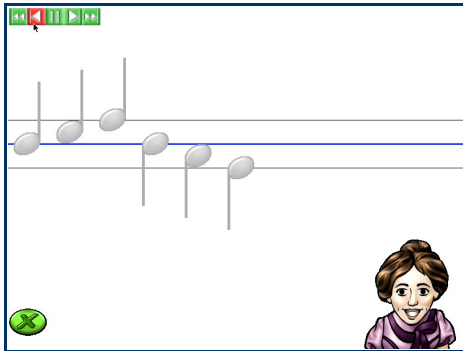




Lesson 19
